- The RSUs vest in five equal annual installments beginning on February 22, 2022, subject to the reporting person's continuous service to the Company or a related entity on such date.
- The shares subject to this option vested and became exercisable yearly in seven installments beginning on March 26, 2015, as follows: 10% of the shares subject to the option vested on each of March 26, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019; and 25% of the shares subject to the option vested on each of March 26, 2020 and 2021.
